3. Eligibility

Overseas Koreans who have completed at least 9 years of schooling, or have the equivalent or higher academic background that has been approved by the Korean Embassy or their local consulates abroad

5. Documents for Submission

- ① Application form (prescribed form) 1 copy
- ② Certificate of (prospective) graduation of the last school attended 1 copy
- ③ Schooling records from the highest level of schooling attained 1 copy

- ④ Documentation proving status as overseas Korean 1 copy
(Such as a resident card, alien registration card that mentions all family members, or a certificate of overseas adoption for overseas adopted persons)
- ⑤ A copy of passport
- ⑥ Study plan (prescribed form) 1 copy

6. Where to obtain & submit application forms

Korean Embassies or Consulates abroad, Korean Education Centers abroad, and the Korean Residents Union (Mindan) in Japan

7. Admission Procedures

- Applications submitted by overseas Koreans to be recommended to NIIED from overseas Republic of Korea diplomatic missions following a review of all required documents.
- The director of the National Institute for International Education will inform the president of Kongju National University and the agency to recommend the list of selected persons among the applicants recommended by diplomatic offices.
- The president of Kongju National University will send the admission results and invitation (or standard university acceptance letter) to the pertinent heads of official residence.
- The president of Kongju National University will provide successful applicants all administrative services required for actual enrolment, including entry support, registration, and dormitory allocation.

8. Other

- In case details included in application and other required documents are found at variance with the facts, admission and course completion may be cancelled not only during enrollment but also after completion of the course.
- For provision of financial aids, academic performance, attendance, general comportment, and financial status of family will be considered.

College(or graduate school) preparation

- Various programs are organized for college (or graduate school) hopefuls.
- TOPIK camp, presentation on college (or graduate school) admission, and campus tour.
- Supporting application for college admission.
- Creating Korean lecture toward college study and lectures in specialty areas

Training in homeland

- Expansion of experience-focused education in Korean history and Korean culture.
- Implementing experience-focused education in Korean history and Korean culture by creating subjects in Korean history and Korean culture such as Doing History, Doing Culture, Media History of Korea, and History Talk.
- Yearly 24 sessions of weekly cultural experience as for the long-term curriculum.

Careers (jobs)

- Various programs promoting domestic and international employment
- corporate visits, employment lectures, job camps etc.
- Building Korean skills needed for jobs in Korea.
- Providing opportunity to sample various jobs through partnership with organizations.

Common program

- Required subjects: Korean, Korean History, and Korean Culture as needed in understanding homeland.
- Electives and extracurricular activities: Field Experience, Cultural Experience, Homestay, Sports Competition, TOPIK Intensive, Clubs, and Exchange Program as customized by theme.

Field Study

- Offering a field study in search of our ancestors' souls or a field study that brings light on various looks of Korea.

Learning through Experience

- Offering various and useful opportunities that help correctly understand Korean culture and create intimacy with Korea.

Events Designed to Improve Korean Learning Ability

- Various events are held with a view to bringing light to the excellence of hangul for those participants studying in homeland and making hangeul a culture in daily life.
- Korean speaking contest, poetry reading competition, essay writing contest, hangeul sketch contest, photo exhibition with story etc.

Club Activities

- Enhance self-governance through voluntary operation of and participation in events by students.
- Promoting friendship among students through group activities.

Buddy Program

- Four full meetings and minimum once a week voluntary get-together or meeting.

Homestay

- Establishing homogeneity and identity as Koreans through experiencing family culture in homeland. Minimum once every semester (optional)

Scholarship

- Types of Scholarship and Specifics

No.	Scholarship	Description	Amount
1	National Scholarship	Selection will consider recommendations from diplomatic office abroad and the number of participants from countries.	Tuition(Educational cost, Dorm, Meal) and part of air fare.

TOPIK Intensive Class

What is TOPIK? It is the abbreviation for Test of Proficiency in Korean, and a TOPIK score is indispensable for anyone who wants to study at a Korean university or work for a Korean company. To improve students' TOPIK scores, TOPIK Intensive Class is offered after school twice a week, so those students who are interested can fill out an application and submit it.

- **Target** : A student who aims to go to college and needs a TOPIK score.
- **Class materials** : TOPIK Questions

Customized Academic Advancement

- Information and counseling provided on academic advancement for students who think of applying to colleges (or graduate schools) in Korea.
- Running customized guidance on documents preparation, application submission, writing personal essay, and interview preparation for admission categories (overseas Korean nationals or foreigners).
- Job-related worries and questions addressed through talks with previous classes of program participants who are attending domestic colleges (or graduate schools).
- Minimum 90% of college aspirants are admitted to domestic colleges (or graduate schools).
