

## 7. Important Notes & Campus Guide



### 1. Required Documentations

- ① Required documents :
  - University : 1 set of original(or notarized) documents
  - Embassy : 1 set of original(or notarized) documents and 3 sets of copies.
- ② Documents not in English or Korean must be accompanied by a complete and accurate English or Korean translation certified by the issuing institution.

#### Required Documents

01. Application Form
02. NIIED Pledge
03. Personal Statement
04. Study Plan
05. Two Recommendation Letters(from two different recommenders stated below)  
(Applicant's high school teacher, principal, or academic advisor, etc)
06. Personal Medical Assessment
07. Graduation Certificate of High School(Expectant graduate : Provisional Graduation Certificate of High School)
08. High School Grade Transcripts(including a description of the school grading system, and transcript converted into percentile, or transcript with ranking in the entire classes)
09. Proofs of Citizenship of the Applicant and his/her Parents(A Birth Certificate, a Certificate indicating Parents-child Relationship, or Parents' Passport, etc.)
10. Certificate of Korean or English Proficiency(if applicable)
11. Certificate of Health authorized by a medical doctor(only for candidates who successfully pass through the 2nd round of selection)
12. Copy of the Applicant's Passport(only for candidates who successfully pass through the 2nd round of selection)

### 2. Important Notes

- ① Screening is based on the applicant's GPA in High School, personal statement, study plan, language proficiency(Korean and English), and Interview etc.
- ② Students who are enrolled in the College of Engineering, College of IT Engineering, School of Agricultural Civil & Bio-industrial Engineering in the College of Agriculture & Life Sciences must complete the ABEEK (Accreditation Board for Engineering Education of Korea) program.
- ③ Most of courses in undergraduate are taught in Korean Language, but only some subjects are taught in English.
- ④ For other details including qualifications, KNU follows NIIED's Guidelines
- ⑤ Major or department of successful candidate can not be changed after KNU's announcement on the selection results.

### 3. Dormitory

- ① Fee : Approximately 300,000Won/Month
- ② GKS scholars will be given a chance to live in the dormitory.
